Eligibility

Middle leaders who are aspiring to senior leadership and meet the following criteria:

- Likely to be in a senior leadership role in the next 12-18 months
- Have completed at least one year at a middle leadership level
- May have served on an extended SLT or
- Senior Leaders who have responsibility for the results of team and line manage at least one middle leader
- On SLT and attending SLE meetings
- Assistant or Vice Principal
- Head of department, subject lead

NPQSL Programme

The main focus of this programme is the participant’s own leadership development including how to make the best use of tasks and tools to make the transition to senior leadership.

The programme will consist of 6 half day face to face sessions and 1 full day session led by two experienced facilitators who are both current serving senior leaders, held at Birmingham locations.

All participants will be assessed through a written assignment focussing on an in-school impact project to ensure they have reached the qualification requirements plus a viva interview to assess them against the more challenging Ambition bar.
