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## COURSE OUTLINE

The training starts in early October 2018 and runs through to June 2019. The training has been broken down into three modules, based on the Teacher Standards.

### **Mentor Training**

Tuesday 18th September 3.30 - 5.00pm 2018

A mentor training session for new and experienced NQT mentors.

### **Module 1**

#### ***Teacher Standards, Behaviour and Relationship Management***

Tuesday 2nd October 2018

This introductory session will include an overview of the programme, exploration of The Teacher Standards, tips on lesson observations and Personal Impact as an NQT.

Monday 19th and Tuesday 20th November 2018

The 2 day residential is held at the 4\* Clayton Hotel, Birmingham City Centre. The focus is all about behaviour management of your self, your class and your stakeholders. There is a session from a SEND expert on strategies and practical advice.

### **Module 2**

#### ***Teaching and Learning***

Session 1: Tuesday 8th January 2019

The morning session will focus on teaching, writing, including marking, assessment and target setting. The afternoon session is all about teaching PE.

Session 2: Tuesday 7th February 2019

This full day session will be looking at teaching maths in all primary key stages focussing on curriculum, target setting, assessment and lesson structure. It will also cover SEN maths. A highly interactive session.

Session 3: Tuesday 19th March 2019

This full day session will be focussing on 'learning to read' and 'reading to learn' including an NQT introduction to Reciprocal Reading and encouraging reluctant readers.

### **Module 3**

#### ***My Career Path***

Tuesday 4th June 2019

This session will be exploring career paths for the post NQT year. It will cover the appraisal process, leadership pathways and how to ensure you are marketable and ready for the next step. The afternoon will be an off site trip covering educational visits.
