

Level 5/6 Certificate in Primary School Physical Education Specialism



This qualification aims to develop professional practice in order to improve the overall delivery of the physical education curriculum within primary schools and raise standards. The qualification includes understanding the requirements of the primary school physical

education curriculum, the links between the principles of pedagogy and child development and how using a range of activities can impact on 'good or better' teaching and learning. The course is suitable to teachers, higher level teaching assistants, teaching assistants (TAs) and coaches (who assist teachers in their PE teaching). Delegates are not required to have Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) for level 5, but must have to complete level 6.
